# FOUNDER STORY AND JOURNEY OVERVIEW

Yasmin Topia, serial entrepreneur, embarked on her journey in the AI space by co-founding Sociate AI, aiming to revolutionize the online shopping experience. Initially driven by a passion to make online shopping more engaging and intuitive, Yasmin leveraged her deep tech venture builder experience and her business development acumen from her tenure at companies like Adeco and PwC.

She recognized a significant gap in how online shopping platforms utilized AI, particularly in the fast-paced, trend-driven fashion industry. Yasmin's vision was to create an AI that could keep up with and even anticipate fashion trends, making the shopping experience more personalized and responsive.

### INITIAL PROBLEM AND EVOLUTION

The initial focus on developing "curious AI" technology evolved as they learned more about customer needs. They discovered that while users sought personalization, they didn't necessarily want a conversational AI.

This insight shifted their approach to developing an AI that could intuitively understand and respond to user inputs visually, akin to a personal stylist but more efficient and scalable.
